- Depart for Seoul, Korea on May 12, 2014 & return to Atlanta on May 25, 2014 (tentative dates; approx. 2 weeks abroad)
- GSU students will be paired with & collaborate closely with a Korean university student partner.
- GSU students stay in shared hotel, hostel, or student housing rooms.
- Program is *open to any GSU students* over 18 years of age with an interest in Korea & the educational system of Korea, especially in regards to child development.
- Program size is limited to 20; students register for ECE 4700 or ECE 8000 (3 credit hours); a syllabus will be provided.
- Cost Estimate: \$3320 (includes airfare estimate, accommodations, ground transportation, meals, educational lectures, comprehensive walking tours, health/travel insurance); 10 students will be guaranteed a \$1000 IEF scholarship (priority given to education & education-related majors)
